

BIOGRAPHY OF EUNICE DAVID

Having received training at the Coro Foundation, Eunice David was well versed in governmental duties when she was appointed by the Governor of California to the Commission of the Californias, a state-level commission dealing with matters concerning the State of California, and how it interacts with the two states of Baja California.

She was also appointed by the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors to the Los Angeles County Music and Performing Arts Commission, a 15-member Commission, which apportions County funds to various arts organizations, such as the Los Angeles Philharmonic, Center Theatre Group, and the Music Center Opera, as well as a wide variety of other performing arts groups throughout Los Angeles County.

Eunice was involved in urban planning, as Director of Zoning for the City of Valencia, from its inception through the development of the new, now flourishing city.

Mrs. David and her husband, the Academy-Award-winning songwriter Hal David, annually produce the highly acclaimed show “The Writer, The Singer, The Song”, featuring songwriters telling stories about their songs and showcasing the artists who made those songs popular.

Eunice chaired the Distinguished Artist Award Gala for the Los Angeles Music Center (the west-coast equivalent of the Kennedy Center Honors) and sits on the boards of the prestigious Blue Ribbon Organization in Los Angeles as well as the Board of Directors of the Los Angeles Music Center. She is the author of numerous travel journals which incorporate her passion for writing, travel, and photography.

Eunice currently serves on the California Arts Council.
